

PARADE SCHEDULE

Officially begins at 10am

- 7:00 – 8:00 Equestrian Entries arrive
- 8:00 Equestrian pre-judging in Stage Area 1. Late arrivals will be penalized.
- 8:00 – 9:00 Non-Equestrian Entries arrive. Norbridge is closed to all traffic
- 8:30 – 9:30 Non-Equestrian judging in Staging Areas 2-6. Late arrivals will not be judged
- 9:00 Streets closed. Late arrivals walk in. They will not be allowed to be dropped off by car.
- 9:00 Parade starts lining up along Nunes towards CV Blvd.
- 10:00 Parade Begins and enters Castro Valley Blvd.**
- Non-Equestrian awards will be announced as entries go past the Reviewing Stand.
- ~11:30 – 12:00 Parade leaves Castro Valley Blvd. Parade ends
- ~12:00 – 12:30 Equestrian Awards Ceremony in BART Parking Lot about ½ hour after completion of the parade.

Local residents may be escorted to and from the area bounded by CV Blvd. and Norbridge as needed by contacting parade marshals on the day of the parade or calling 510-402-5001 in advance.

STREET CLOSURE AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS

STREETS CLOSED - 9AM TO 1PM*:

- Castro Valley Blvd from Redwood Rd to Lake Chabot Rd
- Norbridge Ave from BART entrance to Stanton Ave (BART will be accessible from Redwood Rd)
- All local streets bounded by above.
- San Miguel from Somerset to Castro Valley Blvd (9am to 10am) in addition to above area.

NO PARKING - 7AM TO 1PM* on:

- Castro Valley Blvd from Redwood Rd to Lake Chabot Rd
- Norbridge Ave from Wilbeam Ave to Stanton Ave
- Nunes Ave and San Miguel Ave between Castro Valley Blvd and Norbridge Ave
- Kerr St from Baker Rd to San Miguel Ave & NE side of Baker Ave

*Streets will be open and parking available as soon as the parade is over and it is safe to do so.
