## **STREETS CLOSED - 9AM TO 1PM\*:**

- Castro Valley Blvd from Redwood Rd to Lake Chabot Rd
- Norbridge Ave from BART entrance to Stanton Ave. (BART will be accessible from Redwood Rd)
- All local streets bounded by above.
- San Miguel from Somerset to Castro Valley Blvd (9am to 10:15am) in addition to above area.

## **NO PARKING - 7AM TO 1PM\* on:**

- Castro Valley Blvd from Redwood Rd to Lake Chabot Rd
- Norbridge Ave from Wilbeam Ave to Stanton Ave
- Nunes Ave and San Miguel Ave between Castro Valley Blvd and Norbridge Ave
- Kerr St from Baker Rd to San Miguel Ave & NE side of Baker Ave
